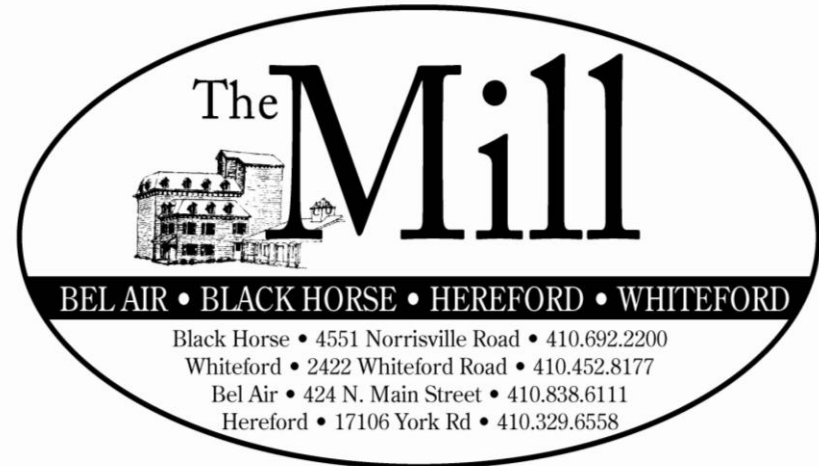

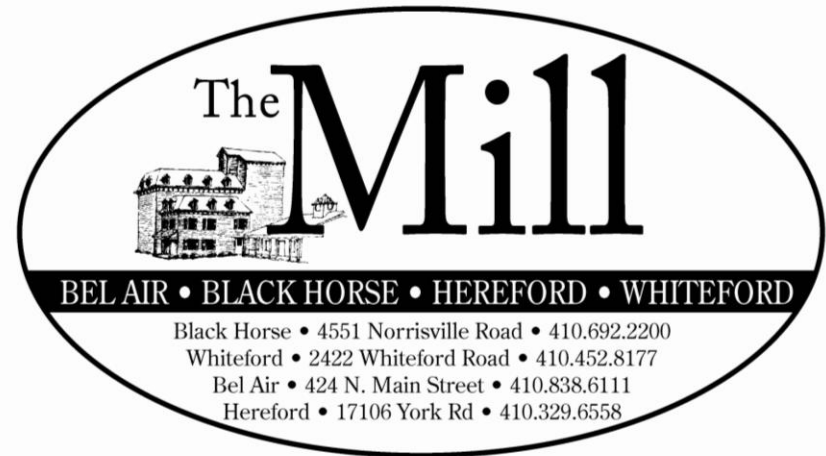

Entries must be sent to show host seven days in advance by noon (if the show is on a Saturday the entries must be received the Saturday before.)

Pre-entries are important because the number of rings, judges and class times is determined by the number of entries we have.

On site entries: \$15.00 per class



General Rules and Regulations

- 1 Riders must wear approved headgear at all times when mounted.
- 2 Proper Attire will be defined as:
 - A. No jeans will be permitted.
 - B. Black helmet-ASTM and SEI approved,
 - C. Breeches with tall boots or paddock boots.
 - D. Riders may wear half chaps with boots (black or brown).
 - E. Riding jackets are not required but rider must wear a sweater, jacket or polo style shirt. Polo shirts must have sleeves.
- 3 Classes may be canceled or combined at the discretion of the show committee or management.
- 4 Hunting Ground and Clayton Ridge will not offer 2'9" or 3' in the Open Hunter Division pending on demand.
- 5 There must be at least two entries per class.
- 6 All entries will be judged on soundness upon entering the ring and therefore be required to trot at some point before cantering the course.
- 7 Entries may withdraw from a class, but must do so with the secretary before the class.
- 8 No martingales in under saddle or english pleasure divisions.
- 9 Classes for juniors will be restricted to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year.
- 10 There will be no champions or reserves awarded.
- 11 There will be end of series prizes donated by The Mill.
- 12 Individual farms may elect to keep track of their farms points and provide awards accordingly.
(Paddock Place Only)
- 13 Medal classes will only be for the hosting farm's riders.
- 14 The show committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or injury that may occur to any horse, exhibitor, groom, attendant, spectator, animal, vehicle or other equipment on the grounds.
- 15 All entries must have proof of negative coggins dated within 12 months of the last blood test.
- 16 For all other rules & regulations, kindly refer to the USEF Rule Book.

Class Descriptions

Equitation, Pleasure & Hunter Divisions

Leadline Division

Open to riders 7 and under as of 12/1 of the previous year.
May also ride in Beginner.

Beginner Division

Open to riders 10 and under as of 12/1 of the previous year.
May also ride in Short Stirrup.

Short Stirrup Division

Open to riders 10 and under as of 12/1 of the previous year.
May also ride in Warm Up.

Limited Division

Open to riders age 11 and over as of 12/1 of the previous year or a rider 10 and under as of 12/1 of the previous year who is riding a horse. May also ride in Warm Up.

Warm Up Division

Open to all riders.. Fences 2' and 2'3"

Childrens Hunter Division

Open to horses and ponies. Junior Riders. Fences 2' or 2'3"

Pleasure Division

Open to horses and ponies of any breed. Martingales are prohibited. Fences 2' or 2'3"

Adult Equitation

Senior Riders. Judged on the rider.

Childrens Equitation

Junior Riders. Judged on the rider.

Farm Children's Medal (*Open only to the farm hosting the show.*)

Juniors Riders. Riders to be called by for a under saddle portion.
The number to be decided by the judge.

Farm Senior Medals (*Open only to the farm hosting the show.*)

Senior riders. Riders to be called back for an under saddle portion.
The number to be decided by the judge.

Low Adult Hunter Division

Senior riders.

Open Hunter Division

Open to ponies and horses. Jump heights 2'6", 2'9" or 3'.
(not all heights offered at all horse shows)

Open Trail Class

Open to all riders.

Jumper Divisions:

Low Hopeful Jumper

Open to ponies and horses. Fences 2'3" and 2'6"

High Hopeful Jumper

Open to ponies and horses. Fences 2'6" and 2'9"

Schooling Jumper

Open to ponies and horses. Fences 2'9" and 3'

Jumper Tables to be used:

b. Table II, Sec. 2 (b)—The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed.

If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course.

A competitor with a clear round may dismount, and with assistance if necessary, adjust tack and/or equipment; however, upon the audible signal to begin his/her round, the competitor is responsible to adhering to the 45 seconds rule as per JP134.2.

A competitor who leaves the arena after a clear round (before or after the tone) will be considered to have retired from the jump-off.

If there are no clean rounds and a tie exists for first place there will be one jump-off in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults. It is recommended that no more than ten numbered obstacles be included in the first round when the class is scored under this table.

c. Table II, Sec. 2 (c)

Two Phase Competitions - The first round and **immediate** jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed if any.

If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, he will, upon crossing the finish line, commence the designated jump-off course.

Time starts as the horse crosses the finish line for the initial course. If there are no clean rounds and a tie exists for first place, there will be one jump-off, in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults. The use of a Time Allowed is optional in the first round.

The Time Allowed in the first round may be taken by electronic or manual means.
